Overview

Player Preparation

Session Format

Below is a guide for each session. However, experience has shown us that planning for players at this age does not always work so we will also use our judgment on the day depending upon the mood of the group.

Phase	Time Sunday/Thursday	Description
Arrival	8.15-8.30am/3.30-3.45pm	Arrive, get organised and play with friends/parents
Warm up	8.30-8.35am/3.45-3.50pm	Includes some running, stretching and some relays
Skills	8.35-9.00am/3.50-4.15pm	Batting, bowling and fielding drills
Break	9.00-9.05am/4.15-4.20pm	Quick drink break especially on hot days
Game	9.05-9.30am/4.20-4.45pm	Practice skills developed in a game format
